**Kings Clipstone Neighbourhood Plan Proposal Submission**

I am writing to you as someone who Kings Clipstone Parish Council consulted on their Draft Neighbourhood Plan from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017 to 19<sup>th</sup> November 2017. The plan has now been submitted to this Council and the Neighbourhood Planning Regulations require that we notify you of this.

The submission plan meets the necessary requirements and therefore complies with the criteria for a neighbourhood plan. It will now be placed on deposit for a period from 29<sup>th</sup> August 2018 to 5pm on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2018 during which time you can make representations. The plan, accompanying documents, SEA Re-screening Statement and Representation Form are available at the District Council Offices – Castle House, Clipstone, Ollerton and Warsop Libraries and Edwinstowe Parish Council offices during normal opening hours and also on this Councils website at: <http://www.newark-sherwooddc.gov.uk/planningpolicy/neighbourhoodplanning/>

Any comments you wish to make about the Kings Clipstone submission version Neighbourhood Plan, supporting documents and SEA Re-screening Statement should be made on the Representation Form and returned by email to [planningpolicy@nsdc.info](mailto:planningpolicy@nsdc.info) or by post to Castle House (address above)

Following this, the plan, together with any representations received, will be submitted for independent examination. The independent examiner will consider the representations and examine whether the plan meets the 'Basic Conditions' and other relevant legal requirements. The independent examiner may recommend that the plan does not proceed to referendum if it does not meet these requirements or, if it does, they may recommend that it proceeds with or without modification to referendum.

Following receipt, the examiner's report together with any recommendations the Council propose in light of it will be publicised on the Councils website. If the plan proceeds to a referendum a further 6 weeks' notice will be given before this takes place.

## **Privacy Notice**

The Council is carrying out a public consultation exercise on behalf of Kings Clipstone Parish Council in relation to the Neighbourhood Plan which has been submitted. As you have been consulted at an earlier stage the Parish Council have provided your details to enable us to undertake this consultation.
