

Edwinstowe Parish Council is having to adjust the way things are done on its behalf at this time of national crisis. The Clerk and Administrator are, for the most part, working from home, in line with Government guidelines. Our amenity workers are carrying out essential work as they are able to work alone. Street Bins will be emptied, litter will be picked for the time being and the cemetery will be tended as usual. Please be aware that should any of our workers become ill or need to self isolate such activities may have to be curtailed.

The Parish Council play areas and Skatepark have been closed, where possible, in line with Government instructions. The allotments are to remain accessible but only to allotment holders, working in isolation. People who do not have allotments must not go near the allotment sites.
